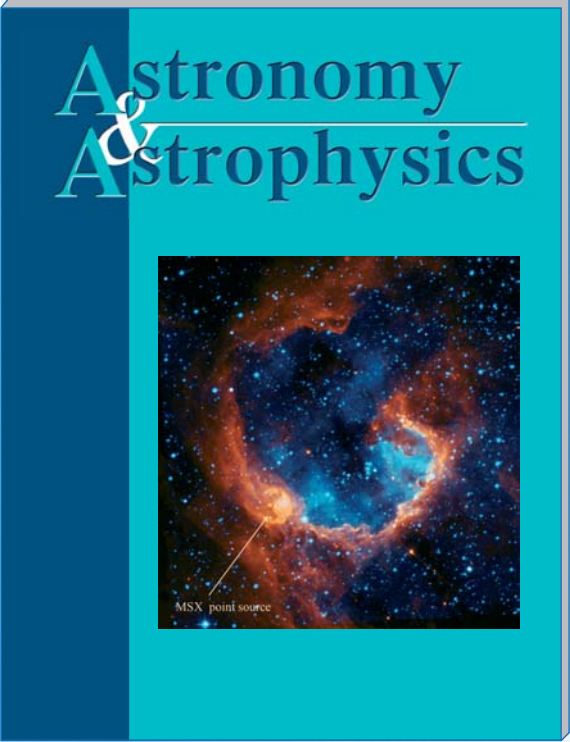

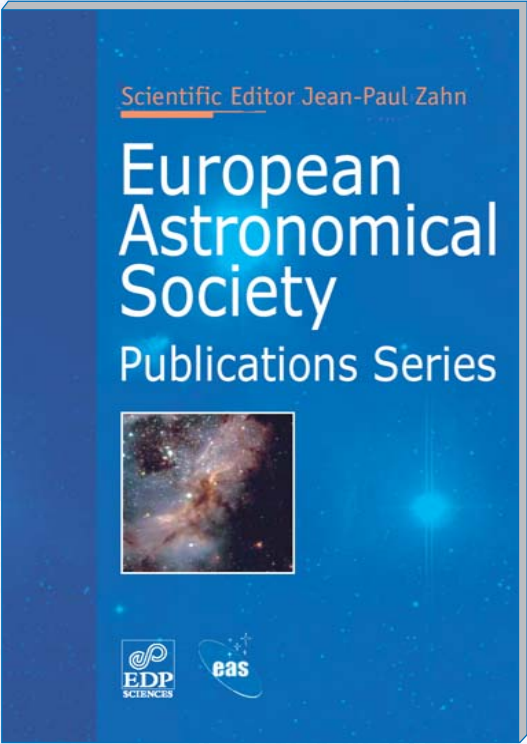

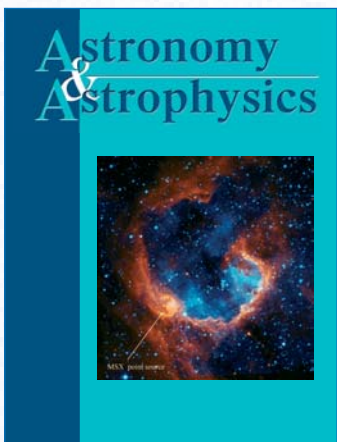

- **LETTERS** concisely present new and important results that deserve fast publication, in no more than four printed pages.

- **REGULAR PAPERS** discuss results of astrophysical research. They are concise but self-contained, with an introduction explaining the purpose of the work and its place in the research field and making extensive use of references.

- **RESEARCH NOTES** are short papers containing either new results as an extension of work reported in a previous paper, limited observations that are not urgent enough to be published as a Letter, or useful calculations that have no definite immediate astrophysical applications.

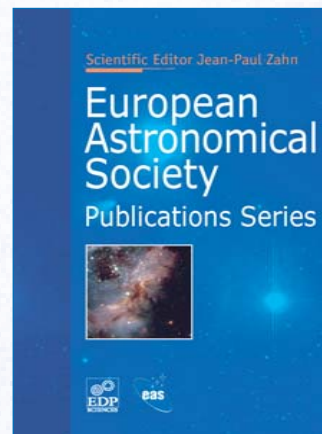
